4. Name a character or group of people from the book who are not good examples of Gerstell's motto: Leadership, Honor, Courage.
5. From the book, describe an event which reflects the lack of Leadership, or Honor, or Courage by this character or group of people.
6. Explain your reason for choosing this event and use text support to be specific about why you think this character or group of people lacked Leadership, or Honor, or Courage. This answer should be written in paragraph format (7-10 sentences).
